Week of May 4th

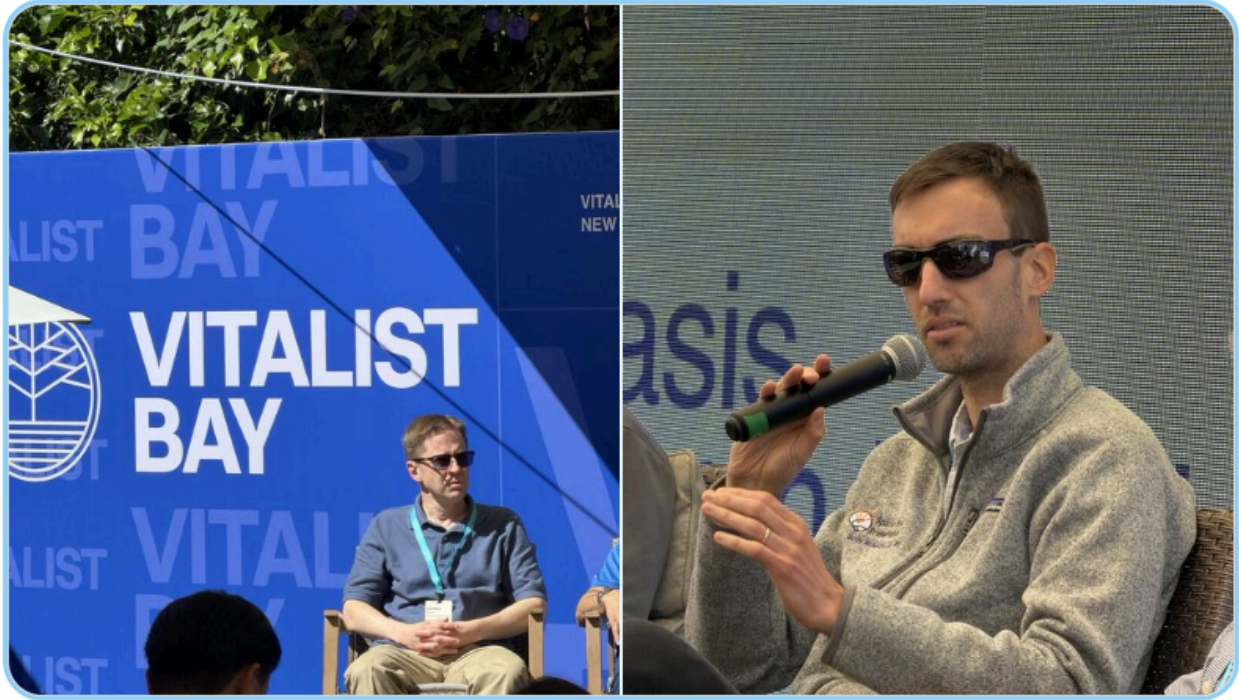
